- Get to know the staff, other volunteer facilitators, and be ready to collaborate and work together as a team.

- Create a supportive, respectful, and inclusive space for all campers.
- Lead by example, demonstrating integrity, enthusiasm, and professionalism.
- Monitor camper engagement and provide guidance, encouragement, and mentorship during sessions and activities.

Administrative Duties (Keep Things on Track!)

- Complete required lesson plan documentation.
- Report any incidents or concerns as required.
- Provide feedback to help improve future camps and program activities.
